

Northbrook Slalom Skiers Briefing

- All slalom handles will be measured at the start dock after you have skied. If your handle is long you will be disqualified.
- Only skiers on the start dock please this includes the beach that the clubhouse neighbours are kindly letting skiers walk over to get to the dock. **CHILDREN SKIERS ON START DOCK MUST BE SUPERVISED.**
- There will be one tournament supplied slalom handle
- When you have completed your slalom run you must pull in at the end of the course, at the clubhouse. You must **NOT** pull in to the side of the slalom course
- Set down times are 25seconds at the clubhouse end (basically time to change the rope) and 50seconds at the subdivision gates end. If you elect to spin **NO** re-ride will be given for poor water conditions.
- There will be no gate cameras and no gate reviews. But there will be 5 pairs of second class judge eyes on every pass.
- All skiers are to stay behind the boat going around the islands.
- If you notice you need to make an urgent repair to your slalom equipment when on the start dock, you have 3 min to be ready to ski.
- For tournament supplied equipment failure that takes longer than 10min you will be given a warm up pass
- When you fall or crash and you are **OK** you must raise your hand to signal the boat
- Soap will be tournament supplied

Our first Aid person is Richard Wood and will be based around the clubhouse.

We have First Aid equipment available at the Club House.

We are operating under the NZTWSA Safety Plan and encourage everyone to be familiar with it. It is available on the NZTWSA web site

There are **NO** shoes or Reflex Boots to be worn in the tournament boat

No congregating on any beaches or at peoples homes, this is all private property. **Please stay off.** Tournament viewing is from the clubhouse or alternatively from the beach outside the forest opposite the clubhouse.

There are to be no cars parked in the clubhouse carpark, please park on the road. The clubhouse carpark is for people, ski gear and getting changed.

We will have coffee available to purchase from the clubhouse bar area in the morning and a sausage sizzle for lunch. Every skier gets one free sausage.

We will also possibly be having a dinner on Saturday evening (depending on numbers), book with the coffee person in the morning.

We ask that in all instances that you respect the site, its equipment and everybody on site.
