COLOMBIA

The Republic of Colombia is the fourth largest country in South America, with around 1,139,000 square kilometers of territory. It is the only South American nation that borders both the Atlantic and Pacific oceans, which allows it to have 2,900 kilometers of coastline.

The Colombian national territory also encompasses three branches of the Andes Mountains and a wide range of thermal floors and agricultural conditions that are distributed in 6 regions, 32 departments and 1,102 municipalities.

The country has 46 million inhabitants and about 10% of the world's biodiversity.

If an athlete participates in their own division and in the Open division, he/she must pay an additional registration fee.

Skiers' registration in the EMS can be done as follows:

- The EMS Federation administrator must log in to the EMS.

- Go to the Competitions menu and enter the catch: "24PANA02" Select the competition for the event.
- Enter all your participants (Any registrations after the September 4th deadline will be put on a waiting list to be approved by the scorer).

Penalties will be collected at the event site.

Unofficial Training

Training at the official venue from Monday, September 30, 2024 until Sunday, October 5, 2024 and at a cost of \$300US for 60 minutes, \$150US for 30 minutes, and \$75 US dollars for fifteen minutes. The minimum set established will be 15 minutes.
