- 1 round of tricks
- 2 rounds of jumps

Competition ends around 16:00

Disciplines:

Slalom, tricks, jumps

Two rounds in each discipline, with the best result determining the winner.

Categories:

- Dolphins: 14 years and under
- Junior: 17 years and under
- U21: 21 years and under
- Open: no age restrictions
- 35 years and over
- 45 years and over
- 55 years and over
- 65 years and over
- 70 years and over
- 75 years and over

Additionally, you can register for the open beginner slalom category, where results are unofficial and the beginner category rules apply.
