We are excited to build on the success of the previous events at OWSC and host The Friends of Tournament Youth Festival which will continue this year built within the event. We look forward to welcoming back those who have attended previous events and extend a warm welcome to those who are visiting us for the first time.

With Lincoln Water Park ([Lincolnwaterpark.co.uk](http://Lincolnwaterpark.co.uk)) on the far side of the ski lake, there will be plenty of fun for all the family this year as well as fabulous food and drinks available on site at The Boat House Café. There will also be various food options on some evenings, details will be posted nearer the time.

## THE SITE

Hazelwood Ski World is a 3 Lake site with Lake 1 being the main competition lake, Lake 2 is a smaller ski lake and Lake 3 has the Aquapark sited on it. We have a drive slow and responsibly policy on site. You can access the Water Skiing from the Aquapark and Cafe entrance or through the Skiing entrance which leads to the start dock, competition jetty and camping. You will be able to camp onsite, we do have some electric points and there are toilets and showers onsite.

## ENTRY

- Entries must be made online via the IWWF Event Management System (EMS).  
**The Competitions are now open for entries.**
- The procedure for acceptance of entries as detailed in the Waterski Additional Rules will be applied for this competition.
- **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRY is 9<sup>th</sup> August 2024**

## QUALIFYING STANDARDS

The entry standards as defined in the Additional Rules are again being waived for this year and the following will apply:

U10/U12 - No qualifications required but if an U12 wants to jump **they must have a registered Jump score in a Competition at any time.**

U14/U17/U21/Open - No specific qualifications needed but must have a registered score at any time in the past for the events entered.

35+ - No qualifications needed but must have a registered score at any time past for the events entered.

Adaptive - No qualifications required.

**Please note that both a British Competitors Licence and an IWWF Licence are required.  
A one off IWWF Licence can be purchased on EMS**

Skiing Disciplines – Slalom Only

Rules – will replicate the Cotswold Series grass roots rules - 4 passes in round one and then eliminator in round 2.

Age & Skier Categories - As above and includes a Novice Category for non-slalom course skiers.

## NUMBERS IN FINALS

### 16.4 NUMBERS IN FINALS

In all National championships, except where other specific rules are quoted, where a final round is included, the number going through to the final of an event is based on the number of skiers on the start list at Midday the day before the Competition

No. of skiers starting in the Preliminary round within an age category & Number in Finals

1 - 5	All
6 - 10	First 5
11 – 12	First 6
13 - 15	First 8
16 – 19	First 10
20 or more	First 12

To qualify for the Final Round a skier must ski and score more than zero in the Preliminary Round.

**Note:** see exceptions for Under 10, Under 12s under British Youth Championships and for 35+ under British 35+ Championships.

Any skier qualifying for the finals and subsequently unable to take part will not be replaced by the next placed skier.

Please Note: Due to the high numbers of entries there will be no B Finals for 35+ Skiers.

## Skiers Entering Age Category and Open Championships

Slalom – There will be only one preliminary round to determine the finalists for both Age Category and Open Events. The exception to this is for skiers who shorten at a different speed in their Age Category. They will ski in both Preliminary rounds.

Tricks and Jump - There will be only one preliminary round to determine the finalists for both Age Category and Open Events.

## FRIENDS OF TOURNAMENT PRIZES

FoT will be giving coaching vouchers to all U17, U14 and U12 skiers who win Gold, Silver or Bronze medals in Slalom, Tricks and Jump. These can be used for a coaching set at any BWSW affiliated club to a value of £35 and will be valid until 31st December 2025. Gold medalists will get 3 vouchers, Silver, 2 and Bronze 1.

## BOATS

Malibu Boats will be the official towboat and official practice behind these boats will be available Monday 26th / Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August (subject to availability) at £15.00 per set (4 slalom, 2 jumps, 2 runs of tricks, to allow for maximum amount of competitors to get a practice).
