Intention to Enter

Each Federation shall submit an Intention to Enter Form no later than **29th June 2024** as per IWWF Wakeboard Rule 3.8.3. The form should be sent to the Event Manager, the Chief Scorer and the Organiser.

Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until they pay a fine of €250.00 to the IWWF. For each participant entered on the Intention to Enter form, the Federation must pay a deposit of €50.00 to the IWWF - this payment is non-refundable. This payment will ensure the number of riders participating is accurate and will enable the planning of the event. If the Federation enters the number of riders as indicated in the Intention to Enter, the payment made will be deducted from the entry fee. If the Federation enters less riders than the number indicated on the Intention to Enter, the €50.00 paid for each of the riders not attending will be forfeited. The Federation may enter up to 2 additional riders more than originally declared on the Intention to Enter form. If more than 2 additional riders participate, then a fee of €50.00 per additional rider will be levied on the Federation. Please indicate your "Country" and "Intent to Enter 2024 IWWF E&A Wakeboard Championships" when making your transfer. An email with a copy of the bank transfer receipt must be to be sent to: Linda.johnston@wakeboardcouncil.com.

Deadline for submission of Intention to Enter is **29th June 2024**

Entry

The deadline for Entry is 18th August 2024.

Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of €10 per rider per day to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered on time.

Registration of Participants in EMS

The registration of rider participations in EMS must be done by an EMS Federation Administrator as follows:

1. EMS Federation Administrator has to login to EMS
2. Go to the Competitions menu and set the Competition Codes and the Country "France" in the Search Filters
3. Select the Competition Code "24EURO10"
4. Scroll down to the Participations section and click the "New participation" button to register the Athletes
5. Enter the Name of the Athlete in the Search box and click on the loop sign to the right
6. Register the Category in Competition, the Event "and the Entry Type.
7. Click on the blue "+Add" button and the participant will be registered.

Repeat Steps 5 to 7 for any additional participants

Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of €10 per day after this deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered. Late entries will only be accepted with the mutual consent of the Organizer and Chief Judge.

IWWF LICENSE

Following an agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an [IWWF License](#) fee from 2021 where athletes wishing to compete in Ranking List / 1 to 6 Star competitions (including IWWF World titled events) in each Sports Division of the IWWF are required to hold an IWWF License. Federations must ensure that all their athletes hold a valid IWWF License in order to participate in the 2024 IWWF E&A Wakeboard Championships.

Flags and Anthems

Each team must bring 2 flags (format 70x100 cm) of their country for ceremonies and medals presentation!

Official Familiarisation (Monday 26 & Tuesday 27 August)

Official Familiarisation will be according to rule 3.7 of the World Wakeboard Rules 2024.

Official Familiarisation will open for booking 15 days following the deadline for the submission of intention to enter forms

Federations are encouraged to book their official familiarisation slots according to the event bulletin as soon as possible, in order to request the schedule that suits them best. Time slots will be allocated on a first come and first paid basis, meaning that when a Federation reserves a slot, it will still be free until it is paid. Only paid slots will be considered reserved.

No refund of payments or reallocation of schedule will be permitted due to lack of readiness from any rider.

Price for official familiarization is 40 € per 1 slot. Strictly only 1 slot per rider

Opening and Closing Ceremonies

- Opening Ceremony – cost will be **15 €** per person
 - Will take place at the site on Tuesday 27th August 2024
 - Cocktail, drinks and meal
- Closing ceremony - cost will be **25 €** per person
 - Will take place at the site on Saturday 31st August 2024
 - Cocktail and drinks before dinner
 - Nice dinner (wine and beers at charge)
 - Concert and fireworks

Be aware, there is no cash machine (ATM's) on site. The nearest machines are located 2 km away, in the centre of Pont-Audemer city.

The following Credit Cards are accepted in most places: **Visa and MasterCard**.

American Express may not accepted everywhere.

Safety

The club sees safety as its top priority, for its members and visitors as well as for its organizers.

Its actions in this area are numerous: annual first aid training for all supervisors, training in the risks of practicing and securing volunteers, safety rules and pilot charter, rescue equipment including defibrillator, hard plan, first aid kits, VHF radio in each boat, CE vests renewed yearly.

- **FIRE & ACCIDENTS** 18

The services reached by dialing 15 and 18 operate in conjunction, with the emergency teams having skills, training and facilities suitable to many situations. "Firefighters" (18) are qualified to provide first rescue and ambulance services.

The caller must :

1. State his/her name and telephone number
2. State the location where assistance is needed
3. State what happened, and if it is still happening
4. State exist any risk of fire, explosion, falls, chemical product...
5. State how many people need help, the nature and severity of injuries
6. Stay online until the operator tells you that you can hang up



Pharmacies /Chemist/Drug Store

- Pharmacies are marked by a green cross (bright when open)
- They are generally open from Monday to Saturday from 08:30 to 19:30.
- Many pharmacies close between 12:00 and 14:00, although in shopping centres and large towns, pharmacies will stay open non-stop.
- At least one local pharmacy will be open on Sundays. Details of and schedule for this "duty pharmacy" (in French: "pharmacie de garde") can be found in every pharmacy window, in local newspapers or by contacting the local police services (commissariat or gendarmerie)
