Set within the beautiful surroundings of Townhill Country Park, less than 5 minutes from Dunfermline City centre. Our Three Event Site is easily accessible from Edinburgh, Glasgow, and Stirling by both car and public transport with Dunfermline Queen Margret station a 20-minute walk away. Onsite we have toilets, hot showers, and changing facilities available, as well as a café.

Our indoor and outdoor viewing platforms allow spectators to watch participants in all weather conditions. We have shared onsite parking with Townhill Country Park which is sufficient for both participants and spectators.

Schedule

The running order will be released on the Sunday 15th of September. The competition will consist of 2 rankings list rounds with a backyard round taking place in between. The opening ceremony and briefing will commence at 7:00am and the first skier off the dock at 7:30am. We are aiming to have the award ceremony by 7:00pm where winners will be announced, and prizes handed out.

Rules

All official practice and tournament events will be pulled behind a 2024 Ski Nautique 200, equipped with the latest version of Zero Off speed control. Driving will be monitored using Surepath and we have a full panel of officiants. Rules will follow the 2024 IWWF rulebook with the British additional rules. S-Lines are the official competition lines and skiers are permitted to use their own handles.
