Entry Conditions & Administration

All athletes must submit their registration to Wake Sports Singapore via https://wakemusters.com/wss-wakefest2022/, and must then be registered by their respective Federation into IWWF's Event Management System (EMS).

a. IWWF's Event Management System (EMS) - https://ems.iwwf.sport/

IWWF's Event Management System (EMS) will be used by the organisers to manage the event. Athletes should request their respective <u>Federation</u> to enroll them in the EMS accordingly

b. Registration of Athletes Using EMS

Each athlete must register to compete in Wakefest Singapore 2022 using IWWF's EMS no later than 30th November 2022. An entry is considered complete when an athlete has registered for the event in EMS and full entry fee payment has been received. Entry fee payment must be made through: https://wakemusters.com/wss-wakefest2022/

The procedure to register for Wakefest Singapore 2022 in EMS is as follows:

- 1. Athlete has to login to EMS
- 2. Go to **My Competitions** and Click on "**New participation**" button. Select the appropriate competition from the list. Filter as follows:
