- The procedure for your Federation to register in EMS is as follows:
 - 1. Athlete has to login to EMS
 - 2. Go to My Competitions and Click on "New participation" button. Select the appropriate competition from the list. Filter as follows:

Code "23HKG005" to compete in Slalom & Trick

- 3. Select your category and click on "Submit Participation" button. Refer here for video tutorial.
- For adult, the entry fee is HK\$750 for one discipline or HK\$850 for two disciplines. (includes both Nationals and Open)
- For junior, the entry fee is HK\$500 (*Juniors born in 2006 or later) for one discipline or HK\$600 for two disciplines (includes both Nationals and Open).
- Anyone is welcome to enter (See Rules below) All Hong Kong based skiers must be HKCWA members in order to join the competition, only holders of Hong Kong Identity Cards will qualify for the Nationals.

- For the age group events, Juniors anyone born in 2006 or later
- \triangleright Masters +45 anyone born in 1977 or earlier
- PLEASE NOTE ONLY ONLINE ENROLMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Enrolments sent by other means ie WhatsApp, Line Tango etc will be automatically disregarded
- We only accept Visa/Master Card/PayPal for online payments. Please keep a record of your online payment for future reference.
- In the event of cancellation of the event prior to the start of competition, due for example to bad weather, entry fees will be refunded to the enrolled skiers through the online payment system.
- Applications from skiers with outstanding payments from past events will not be accepted unless the skier provides evidence of payment or settles the outstanding amount.

Deadline for entry submission via EMS: 16th October 2023 12:00 midnight.

Late entry may be considered depending on the number of entries received.
