Events: Slalom, Tricks, Jump and Overall.

The competition will be held according to the IWWF World Cableski Technical Rules, Edition 2022; Confederation Additional Rules Edition 2022.

This competition will be RC homologated for Jump and Slalom and Trick.

#### 8. Categories:

The competition will be carried out in following categories: U15 girls & boys, U19 girls & boys and Open class - Women and Men (each category requires minimum 3 starters).









## 9. Entry fee:

The organizer will collect an entry fee as follow open class per skier of € 130.-- for 3 events and € 90.-- or each single event. U15 and U19 per skier of € 80.-- for 3 events and € 50.-- for each single event

The entry fee must be paid in Euros at the competition office before the beginning of the official practice.
