4. OFFICIAL TOW BOAT

The event will be towed by a 2022 Centurion Ri230. With as much as 5400 pounds of ballast available, the incredible wakeboard wake of the new 23-foot Centurion Ri230 has become a bigger topic of conversation because it is being generated by the smallest of the Ri Series Centurions. The Ri230 is attacking all areas of innovation simultaneously with a deeper, thoughtfully refined, more aggressively styled and better performing 23-foot wake surf and wakeboard boat. The World's best waves, wakes and ride have gotten even better with the evolved running surface of the Ri230's Opti-V Hull. With 20 degrees of dead-rise at the transom the Opti-V Hull displaces more water with less weight while preserving a great roughwater ride and creating killer wakes. Centurion engineers have added a number of lake life-improving refinements to she Ri230 for as many as 14 people. The 2022 Centurion Ri230 includes Centurion's Remote Engagement Continuous Optimization Network (RECON) telematics by Osmosis, Lay-flat Sun Pad Lounge Seats, Revo 12-inch by 12-inch side by side touch screens, the all new available RAMFILL2or as well call it the "Baller" ballast system, the available Range of View (ROV) bow to stern camera system with live fuel usage data, and the available Centurion Shift Thruster System by CMI.

6. EVENT VENUE

Borgo San Pietro, Lago del Salto, Rieti - Italy





Lago del Salto is a hydro-electric basin built in the early years of the last century, able to guarantee a water reserve and an electricity production capable to satisfy the needs of the resident population between Rieti and Rome.



Today, as host to <u>CNVS WAVE</u> and its boats, it represents one of the most beautiful and technical Italian spots to practice wakeboarding.



It is not a coincidence that Lago del Salto - Borgo San Pietro, has already been selected as the venue for prestigious national competitions from 1998 until today, as well as the venue for the IWWF European Wakeboard Championships both in 2014 and 2018.

10. HOW TO GET THERE

To travel to Rieti and Lago del Salto, you have to fly to Rome Fiumicino (FCO) Airport or to Rome Ciampino (CIA) Airport. Teams, individual athletes, parents and friends will need to organize their own transport as the organizer will not provide transportation from and to the airport, as well as between the hotels and the competition site.

12. COVID-19 SITUATION

Due to the global pandemic situation a covid protocol will be in place, to ensure social distancing and sanity measures will be respected, as well as all the facilities needed to deal with athletes testing.

























13. INTENTION TO ENTER & ENTRIES

According to IWWF World Wakeboard Rules (rule 3.8.3) each Federation shall submit the attached Intention to Enter Form to the Chairman of the IWWF World Wakeboard Council (nuno.eca@wakeboardcouncil.com) and to the Organizer (cnvsworldchampionships@gmail.com). The Intention to Enter Form must be submitted not later than May 24th 2022. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until they pay a fine of US\$250/€250 to the IWWF. For each participant entered on the Intention to Enter form, the Federation must pay a deposit of US\$50/€50 to the Organizer - this payment is non-refundable.

This payment will ensure the number of riders participating at the event is accurate and enable the planning of the event. If the Federation sends the number of riders as indicated in the Intention to Enter, the payment made will be deducted from the entry fee. If the Federation sends less riders than the number indicated on the Intention To Enter Form, the US\$50/€50 paid for each of the riders not attending will be forfeited.

The Federation may enter up to 2 additional riders more than originally declared on the Intention to Enter form. If more than 2 additional riders participate, then a fee of US\$50/€50 per additional rider will be levied on the Federation. Please remember that a penalty of US\$250/€250 will be applied for late submissions.

13.1 AGE GROUPS

A rider's age as of 31st December 2021 will be used to determine the age category. The reason being is the event has been postponed from 2021 to 2022.

13.2 ELEGIBILITY

A Federation may select its team as desired according to the latest IWWF World Wakeboard Rules. However, each team member must be a citizen or applying for citizenship of the country that the Federation represents. In case of doubt as to the nationality of a rider, the Chief Judge and the Chief Calculator normally will refer to his/her passport. If a rider does not have a passport from the country he/she is representing, he/she must prove residence in the country for at last five years and membership in an affiliated club of the Federation. Each Federation shall certify that all members of its team meet these qualifications. Before competition a rider must sign a participation contract and understand the nature of the sport and its special risks. Riders must disclose to the event organizer any special medical conditions, including but not limited to, injuries in the past or present or other pre-existing medical conditions.

























13.3 REGISTRATION OF RIDERS

Each Federation shall register their riders through their Federation's EMS Administrator no later than JULY 15th 2022 (ten days before the scheduled start of the event), through the IWWF Event Management System (EMS). Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of US\$10/€10 per rider per day after the 10-day deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered. Late entries will only be accepted with the mutual consent of the Organizer, Chief judge and WWC Chairman. Registration will close on JULY 23rd at 12h00 a.m. (36 hours prior to the start of the competition). If a rider is not able to be on site before the registration closes, he/she (or the Team Captain) must ensure that a digital copy of his/her passport is sent to the Chief Judge and Chief Calculator and that his/her entry fee is paid, as well as a clear indication of the category the rider will compete in.

The registration of the rider's participation in EMS needs to be done as follows:

- 1. Each Federation's EMS Administrator should login to EMS
- 2. Go to the Competitions menu and set the Code to "22IWWF05" and the Country to "Italy" in the Search Filters.
- 3. Select the 22IWWF05 "2022 IWWF World Wakeboard Boat Championships" competition
- 4. Scroll down to the Participations section and click the "New participation" button to register the Athletes
- 5. Enter the Name of the Athlete in the Search box and click on the loop sign to the right
- 6. Register the Category in Competition, the Event "and the Entry Type if known (if not known yet select "Individual Participant"; you must define the Team Members latest by JULY 23rd at 12:00 a.m. prior to the first day of the Event on site)
- 7. Click on the blue "+Add" button and the participant will be registered
- 8. Repeat the steps 5 to 7 for any additional participants
- 9. Any registration after the deadline of July 15, 2022 will be put on the Waiting List to be approved by mutual consent of the Organizer and the Chief Judge.
- 10. Entry fees and penalties will be collected on site in cash

























13.4 TEAM ENTRY

A team will comprise of a maximum of 10 riders, with a maximum of 2 riders in the same category. Although it is encouraged to have a mixed participation with men and women riders within a team, it is not compulsory. Federations must nominate their team riders by 3:00 pm, one day prior to the first day of the event, after which all riders will be considered individual entries and will not contribute towards team scoring.

13.5 INDIVIDUAL RIDERS

According to the IWWF World Wakeboard Rules (rule 3.8.2), athletes who are not part of a team may compete as individuals. An individual rider's entry must be submitted through his respective Federation or Federation representative, following the same procedure as 13.3.

13.6 ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is US\$250/€220 per rider.

14. IWWF LICENSE

Following an agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF Licence fee from 2021 where athletes wishing to compete in Ranking List / 1 to 6 Star competitions (including IWWF World titled events) in each Sports Division of the IWWF are required to hold an IWWF Licence. It is requested that Federations ensure that all their athletes hold a valid IWWF License in order to participate in the 2022 IWWF World Wakeboard Championships.

15. DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. 16. OFFICIAL FAMILIARIZATION

NB: there is a change to the information regarding the dates provided in Bulletin 1.

Official Familiarisation will take place over 4 days, Thursday 21st July at 08.00 to Sunday 24th July at 15.00.

In order to ensure equity for all riders - each rider will have the opportunity for only 1 slot of 10 minutes.

Official Familiarisation will open for booking on 20th June 2022 at 09.00 hours CET. The process for the booking of Official Familiarisation will be strictly managed by priority according to the date and time of the receipt of email requests to: simona.valerio@libero.it

When requesting for familiarisation slots, please refer to the preferred date and if morning or afternoon is also preferred. Slots will be attributed by order of preference as received by email date and time.

Payment must be made at the time of the confirmation of the booking and is not refundable. Slots cannot be changed following booking confirmation.

WARNING

It is vitally important that all Federations and Team Captains ensure that all of the riders are registered on the EMS and have purchased the IWWF licence.

All riders must be entered for the competition on the EMS no later than July 15th Clear instructions are provided at 13.3 in Bulletin 1

17. OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS

The Opening Ceremony, Closing Ceremony, and Final Night Banquet are offered free of charge to Athletes, Team Officials, Technical Officials, IWWF Wakeboard Council Members and IWWF Executive Board Members.

18. MEALS

Meals will NOT be provided by the organizer for the teams, individual athletes, parents and friends, but a food court with several options will be available on site.

The IWWF Bye-Law 16.1 states: It is the responsibility of each Federation when entering competitors for a World Titled Event to ensure that its competitors are adequately insured for personal accident, permanent disabilities, death and medical expenses.

They should also upload photos for media use. Athletes should contact their respective Federations if they are not active / confirmed EMS users.
