



2022 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships

Bulletin 1

The <u>Korea Waterski & Wakesports Association</u> will host the 2022 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships in Chuncheon, South Korea from 8th to 13th August 2022.

The official arrival dates are from 7th to 9th August 2022 and departure date is 14th August 2022. **Teams are kindly requested to schedule their departures from 14th August 2022 onwards so they can attend the Team Overall Awards Presentation & Closing Ceremony Dinner on 13th August 2022.**

Chuncheon is the capital city of Gangwon Province, South Korea. To the north, rugged Obongsan Mountain is home to the Buddhist Cheongpyeongsa Temple. It features a stone garden, an ancient, 3-story stone pagoda and the secluded Guseong Waterfall. The average temperature in August is between 19°C to 27°C.

Chuncheon hosted the 2009 IWWF World Wakeboard Championships, 2010 IWWF Waterski& Wakeboard World Cup and 2012 IWWF Asia & Oceania Championships.

3. Entry Conditions & Administration

Only paid-up member federations of IWWF Asia are qualified to participate in the 2020 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships. All athletes must be entered by their respective Federations, including individual athletes.

a. IWWF's Event Management System (EMS)

IWWF's Event Management System (EMS) will be used for registration of all participants. Please ensure your federation/ association is enrolled in this system and your athletes are registered accordingly.

b. Intention to Enter: Each federation shall submit to the organizing committee and to the Secretary General of IWWF Asia, not later than 15th May 2022 its intent to compete. Any federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete unless they pay a penalty of US\$5.00 per day to the organizer. Each federation shall submit to the organizing committee and to the Secretary General of IWWF Asia, not later than 1st July 2022, the names of the members of its team, the disciplines (Waterski, Wakeboard & Wakesurf), the events each will enter, the ranking of each skier/rider, as well as the names of the official reserves. Any federation not meeting this requirement may not be allowed to compete, or if so allowed at the discretion of the Chief Judges and the organizing committee until the federation pays a penalty of US\$1.00 per day after the 1st July 2022 deadline to the organizer for each skier/rider not officially entered. If the official entry forms are not received 24 hours prior to the start of the first event, the federation's skiers' and riders' places in the draw, if allowed to participate, shall be determined by the respective Chief Judges without reference to their ranking.

d. IWWF License

Following an agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF Licence fee from 2021 where competitors in Waterski, Barefoot, Cableski Ranking List / Record Capability and 3 to 6 Stars Wakeboard competitions would be required to hold the IWWF Licence. Participants of the Wakesurf discipline do not require an IWWF License at this stage. It is requested that Federations ensure that all their Waterski and Wakeboard athletes hold a valid IWWF License before participating in the 2022 IWWF Asian Championships.













4. Rules - General

The competition will be conducted according to the IWWF Asian Technical Rules for Waterski, Wakeboard and Wakesurf.

The following serves to summarize tournament and wakeboard rules. If there are any contradictions, the 2022 Asian Waterski, Wakeboard and Wakesurf Rules will be used.

Eligibility	A Federation may select its team in any manner it desires; however, each team member must be a citizen or applying for citizenship of the country which the Federation represents. In case of doubt as to the nationality of a competitor, the Judges normally will refer to his passport. If a skier/rider does not have a passport from the country for which he is skiing/riding, he must prove residence in the country for at least three (3) years. 4A. TOURNAMENT TEAM OVERALL COMPETITION - ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION

As per the 2022 IWWF Asian Tournament Rules, there will be four (4) separate team **AWARDS** for Open, Masters+35, Masters+45 and U17. For Open, the best three (3) scores, men **AND** women, in eliminations or finals shall be summed up to obtain the team score. For Masters+35, Masters +45 and U17, the best two(2) scores, men **AND** women, in eliminations or finals shall be summed up to obtain the team score. At least one (1) score for each sex is to be used. The Max Kirwan Shield will be awarded to the team with the highest overall combined team score of these three separate events Open, Junior(U17) and Masters+45.

7. Entry Fee

Entry fee for each athlete will be USD200.00 per sport discipline, ie. USD200.00 to enter waterskiing (slalom, trick and/or jump), USD200.00 to enter wakeboard and USD200.00 to enter wakesurf. This includes airport and venue transfers, lunch on competition days and fee for the Opening Ceremony and Closing Ceremony Dinner. However, if one athlete intends to participate in a cross over discipline, USD150.00 will be charged for the second discipline, ie. athlete enters waterskiing and wakeboard = USD350.00 Entry fee, athlete enters wakeskim and wakesurf = USD350.00 Entry fee. Entry fees must be paid by bank transfer no later than 1st July 2022 This Entry Fee also includes a levy of USD50.00 to assist towards the travel costs of Technical Officials. Currency is in US Dollars. The attached entry form must be submitted by 1st July 2022.





18. COVID-19

Depending on South Korea's quarantine regulations as well the number of expressions of Intents to enter received by 15th May 2022 a decision will be made whether the event can proceed as scheduled.

At present S. Korea does not require quarantine for fully vaccinated visitors.

To be considered fully vaccinated travellers must have had their second dose of a Covid-19 vaccine (except Janssen) at least 14 days and no later than 180 days prior to arrival or have received a booster shot.

Visitors must input their vaccination records in advance of their trip and will be issued with a QR Code prior to departure. See attached Q-code attachment.
