Canterbury is preparing to host Nationals at Lake Crichton in March 2022. Competition will start Tuesday lunchtime (22nd March) and finish Saturday 26th with Prizegiving at the Dunsandel Community Centre on Saturday night.

Some Trick will be run on Lake 2 behind a second Nautique, enabling us to shorten Nationals by one day.

Familiarisation will be run as usual on Monday and on Tuesday morning. This will be optional and at a separate cost to entry fees. Prices have not been finalised as yet.

We will have a marquee and on-site breakfast, lunch and dinners.
