#### 8. INSURANCE & CONSENT FORMS

#### 7.1 USA Water Ski & Wake Sports Insurance

All athletes are required to sign up as members of USA Water Ski & Wake Sports for insurance purpose before they are permitted to compete. #### 8.2 Travel Insurance

#### The IWWF Bye-Law 16.1 states:

It is the responsibility of each Federation when entering competitors for a World Titled Event to ensure that its competitors are adequately insured for personal accident, permanent disabilities, death and **medical expenses**. <u>Please note that the insurance provided by the membership to USA</u> Water Ski & Wake Sports does **NOT** include medical expenses.

# 9. OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS

#### 9.1 Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony will be held at <u>Lake David Park</u> on Tuesday 12th October 2021 starting 6:00 pm. Teams should be dressed in team track suits and be assembled by 5:30 pm. Parking will be located at the <u>corner of 450</u> <u>South Lake Avenue and West Magnolia Street</u>, in Lake David Park; the set off point for the parade of countries will begin there as well as from the splash pad. There will be a reception after the Opening Ceremony with free admission for Athletes, one Team Official per team (or two Team Officials for teams of 8 or more athletes), Technical Officials and IWWF Executive Board Members.

#### 9.2 Closing Ceremony & Final Night Banquet

The closing ceremony and final night banquet will be held at <u>Mission Inn</u> <u>Resort & Club</u> on Sunday 17th October 2021 starting 7:00 pm. Admission to the Closing Ceremony & Final Night Banquet will be free for Athletes, one Team Official per Team (or two Team Officials for teams of 8 or more



athletes), Technical Officials and IWWF Executive Board Members. The cost for all others to attend is USD70.00 per person. Tickets will be available for purchase on site, subject to availability. Final time/date for purchase is at 3:00 pm on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October. Equally Team Officials need to confirm their exact numbers to IWWF by this date. A seating plan will be published beforehand.

# 7.5 IWWF World Congress

The IWWF World Congress will be held on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> October at the <u>Mission</u> <u>Inn Resort & Club</u>. Start time 7:00 pm (1900 hours). All Federations wishing to be present must submit their Delegate Appointment PRIOR to 9<sup>th</sup> October. The form has been sent already to all National Federations.

# 8 LUNCHES ON SITE

Food trucks will be available throughout the event. Lunch will be provided free of charge to Athletes and one Team Official per team (or two Team Officials for teams of 8 or more athletes) on competition days from 12th to 17th October 2021.

# 9 DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, Doping controls will be conducted during the competition. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. **10.2 USA WATER SKI & WAKE SPORTS (USA-WSWS) SAFE SPORT POLICY** As a USA-WSWS sanctioned competition held in the U.S., all event participants must acknowledge that they have read and will follow the <u>Safe Sport</u> <u>Handbook</u>, adhere to the <u>MAAPP (Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Polices)</u>



protocol found in the USA-WSWS Safe Sport Handbook, and report any suspected or alleged MAAPP violations. No event participant, under any circumstance, should be currently listed on the USA-WSWS <u>Suspended</u> <u>Members List</u>. All participating IWWF-affiliated National Federations must assist the local organizing committee (LOC) in being compliant with the <u>Safe Sport</u> <u>Sanctioned Event Expectations</u>.

For participants requiring Antigen tests, the special rate will be \$75.00 per 10-minute result test (standard rate is \$95.00 per test).
